



## Tour n° 2C South Tour

### Roseau, Morne Bruce, Botanical Gardens, Soufrière, Gallion, Scott's Head, Trafalgar falls, Wotten Waven spa

Your day will start with a visit to the capital, **Roseau**, a town whose history is told through its architecture with many old wooden houses. You can admire the botanical garden, **the old market** and the **vegetable market** which is the life of Roseau with vendors from all over the island.

You will then climb to **Morne Bruce**, in the heights to enjoy the panoramic view of Roseau.

#### *Possible option "champagne":*

On your way to the South of the island, at about 1 km from the fishing village of **Pointe Michel**, you will visit the **Champagne** site also called **Pointe Guignard, Anse Bateaux**. At this site, volcanic activity creates thousands of gas bubbles that emerge from the rocks and rise to the surface of the water. You will be able to snorkel and admire these little bubbles more closely.

You will then set out to the southern part of the island to the village of **Soufriere** where you will have the opportunity to take a bath in the hot sulphurated sea water in front of the very beautiful Roman Catholic village Church.

Then you will visit **Scott's Head**, a picturesque fishing village, located at the southernmost tip of the island on the shore of Soufriere Bay, the edge of a crumbling crater where the Caribbean Sea joins the Atlantic. At the far end, connected to the village and to the island by a rocky isthmus, is **Pointe Cachacroux** which offers a formidable view of the bay to the north of the island and of the island of Martinique if the weather is clear. On this point are the ruins of Fort Cachacou, a former defence post from 1778 to 1805. There, you can admire all the shades of colour of the sea (opalescent).

You will continue your tour by visiting **Trafalgar Falls**, located in the **Roseau Valley**.

The hike trail begins after the village of Trafalgar. The first fall called "the father" comes from the **Freshwater lake** and the second called "mother" from **the Boeri Lake**. The two waterfalls converge into Rocky Pools, splattering unto enormous black rocks lined with orchids and ferns. To see them, will take a promenade of about 10 minutes through the spectacular rainforest. For the abled persons, the promenade will continue by climbing onto large rocks in order to reach the falls. Bath of your choice in the beautiful pure crystalline water or in the natural hot water basins.

You will end this day with a visit to Wotten Waven where you will see volcanic hot water resurgences, and for those who wish, take a last hot bath, relaxing the body and eyes in the natural spa at Wotten Waven (Water Heaven), a magical place, located at the bottom of a gorge in the rain forest. You will discover the natural basins of hot sulphurous water that are fed by a constant runoff of volcanic mineral water, coming from volcanic sources of the nearby mountains.
